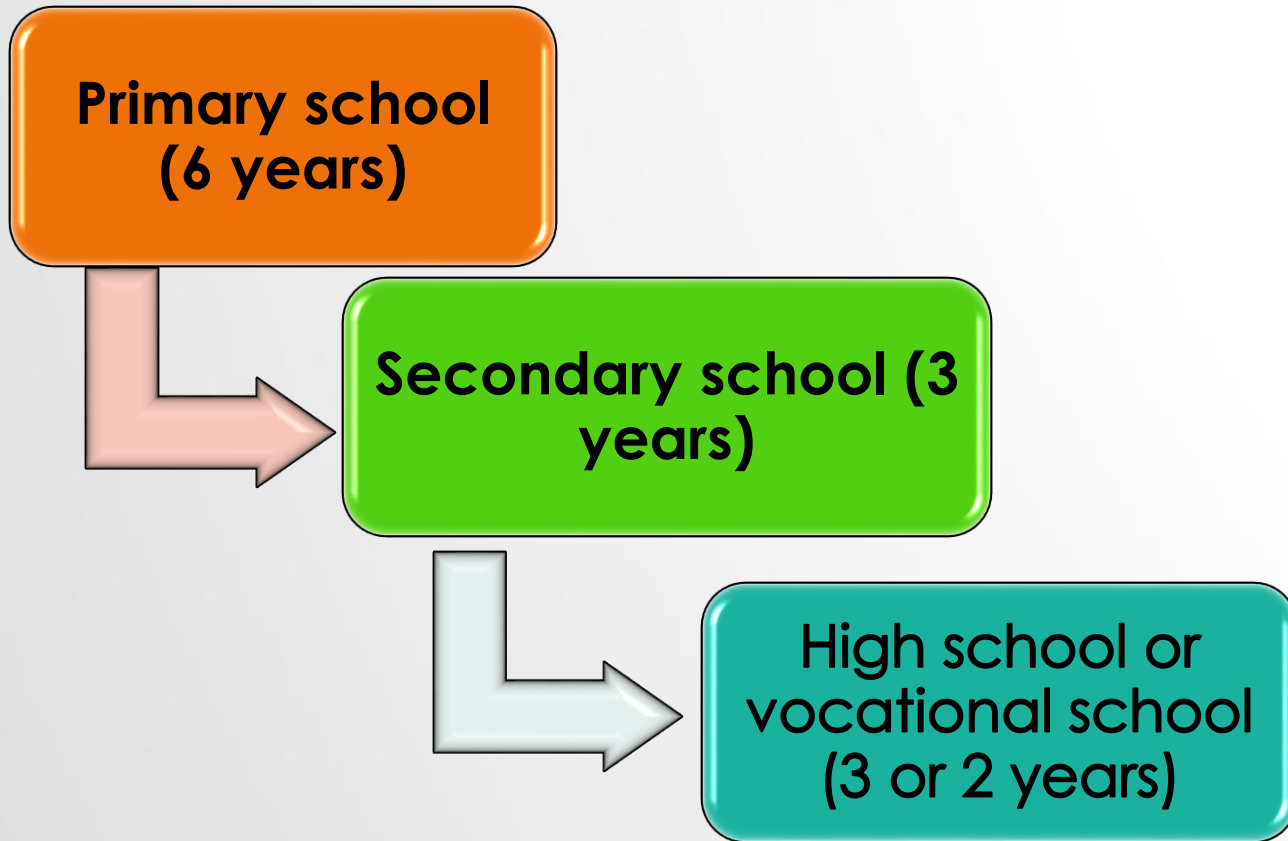

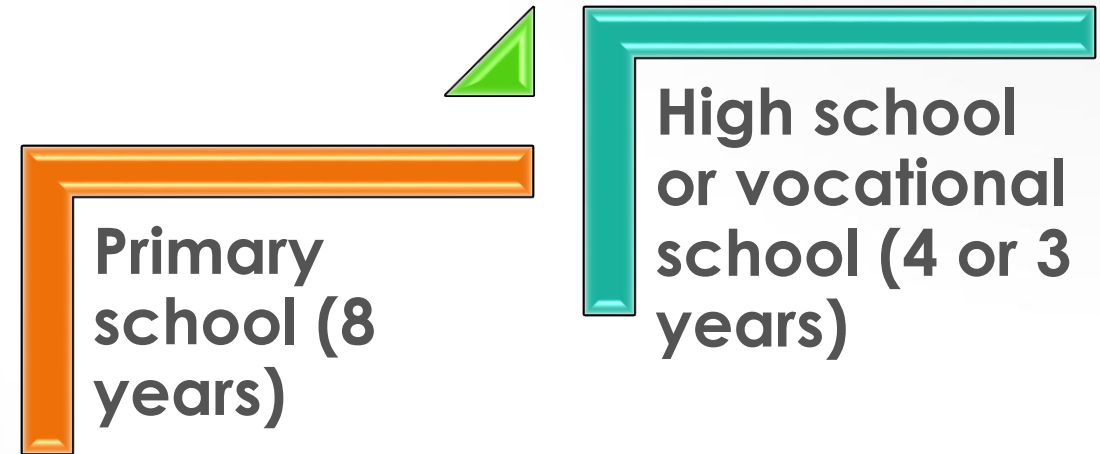
The facts

- The **educational reform** that took place in 2017 introduced two levels of schooling (instead of three levels).
- Having existed for 20 years secondary schools were closed down.
- After this reform children of pre-school age and about 160 students aged between 7 and 15 are taught in our school.

About us

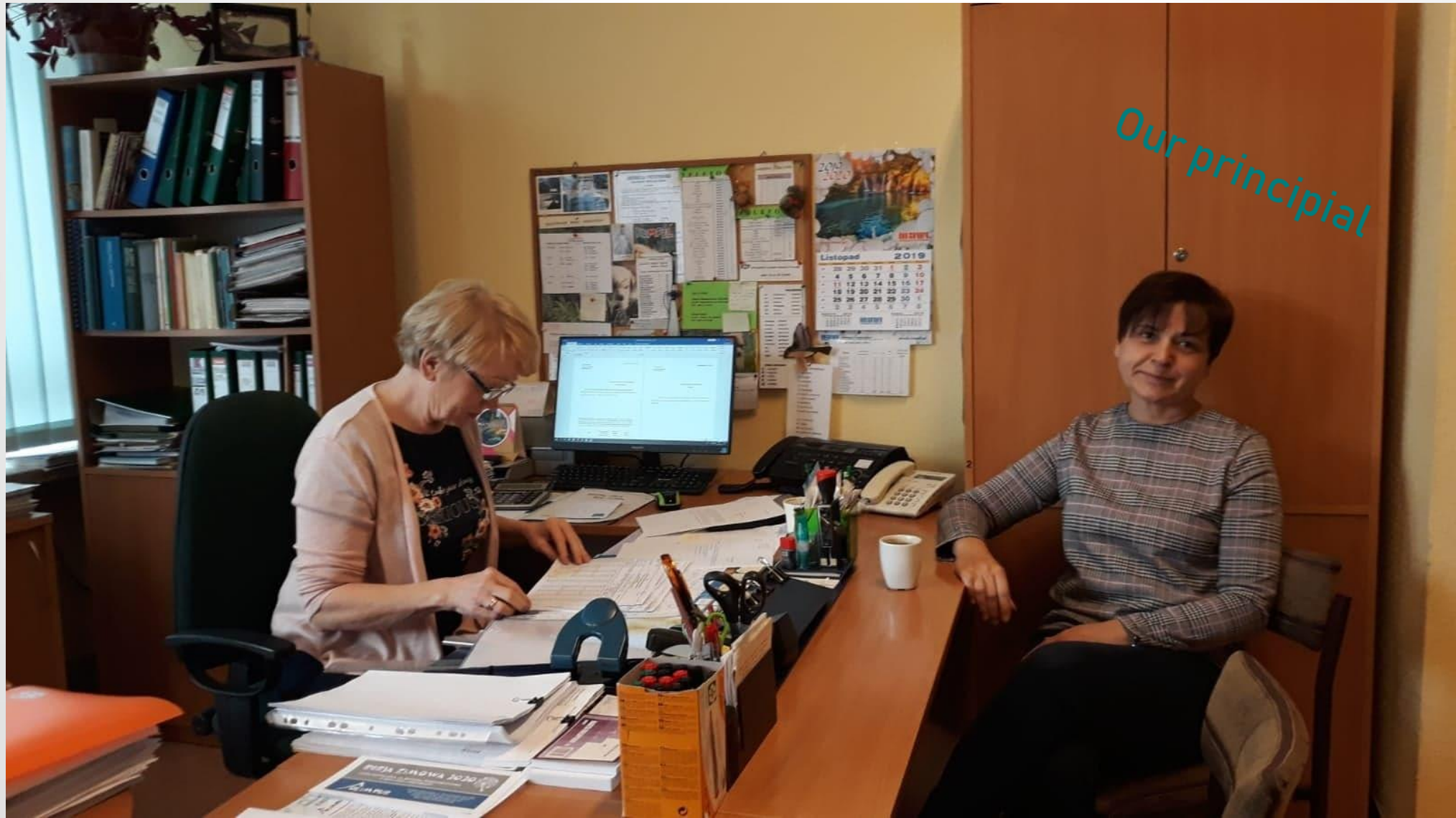
Our school is located next to the woods in a small village **Radostowice**.

It was built in 1991. We've got:

- 12 classrooms,
- one gym,
- a canteen,
- a school library,
- and outside - a playground.



**The principal is Małgorzata Jakubik.
About 25 teachers work in our school.**











Before the reform, as a secondary school, we took part in a **students' exchange** with Sint Lucas. For the first time in 2012.



Our advantages

Our school is located close to **Pszczyna**, a small but charming city. The greatest tourist attraction is the **Castle Museum**. In the Dworcowy Park there is an open-air museum called Zagroda Wsi Pszczyńskiej. In another part of the park the **Bison Centre** is situated.



Close to Auschwitz, Cracow and the mountains

Half-an-hour drive is enough to reach **Auschwitz Museum**, one hour – to reach **The Beskidy Mountains** and two hour drive – to reach **Cracow**.

These are very important places to realize our historical project.
